

Certificate in Teaching and Learning in Extension Application Process for a \$400 Scholarship

sponsored by an
Endowment Grant from the
Alpha Rho Chapter of Epsilon Sigma Phi



Scholarships for *Teaching and Learning in Extension*, a self-study, online course, are available to K-State Research and Extension employees who are directly engaged in educational programming. As a result of funding received from an Epsilon Sigma Phi endowment grant, we are pleased to offer this opportunity to agents, specialists and program assistants. Preference will be given to Alpha Rho Chapter, Epsilon Sigma Phi (ESP) 2013-14 members. **Applications are due by December 6, 2013**; selections will be determined by January 1, 2014.

Submission of an application infers agreement on the part of the applicant to the following:

- Engage in quarterly conference calls and or face to face meetings (dates to be determined by participants).
- Serve on a team to implement future use of the content within K-State Research and Extension.
- Complete the certificate requirements by November 1, 2014. If not able to finish the course within the established guidelines for this scholarship, awardee will repay the Alpha Rho Chapter ESP for the cost of registration (\$400) by January 1, 2015.

Up to six scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:

1. Expressed interest in self-development
2. Potential to improve extension programming
3. Commitment to integrate learning in future programming
4. Quality, organization, and presentation of application



Application process for the \$400 scholarship:

1. In a one-page document, include:
 - a. Name, e-mail address, telephone number, position, and unit
 - b. Response to the question, "**How will your participation in this course be of value to you as an extension professional?**" Consider the criteria listed above and the content of the course outline.
2. By December 6, 2013, submit your application to Doris Merrill by one of the following methods:
